AACTE, in its efforts to [revolutionize education](#), is partnering with [Digital Promise](#) to support their efforts to address systems-level transformation that directly address the challenges students face. To achieve improved educational outcomes, it is essential to recognize that each student differs, and that those differences matter and can be leveraged for learning to occur.

Digital Promise wants to ensure that each student has equitable access to educators and learning experiences that affirm and honor their identities, expertise, and cultures. Through professional development and its free and open-source tool, the [Learner Variability Navigator](#) (LVN), Digital Promise empowers educators to deepen their understanding of learner variability and embrace equitable and inclusive practices that support the whole child.

Purpose of the Focus Group

Teachers create what they experience. In order to have a systems-level transformation, educators must have learning experiences that challenge the status quo of education. Deepening an understanding of learner variability can support the mindset shifts necessary for the learner-centered practices that support equitable outcomes and student success. Digital Promise has seen this mindset shift in K-12 educators who have used the LVN tool, supported by a self-study guide.

AACTE and Digital Promise agree that by adapting Digital Promise's previous K-12 LVN training success to educator preparation programs, we can ensure that learner variability is something that can be incorporated at the early stages of teacher education. To achieve this, we will convene focus groups strategically chosen based on interest, influence, and capacity to learn about the resources available through the Learner Variability Project and what professional development opportunities would be of interest to AACTE members.

What We Hope to Achieve

In a K-12 peer-professional development project on learner variability and the LVP resources, we found that educators were supported in building upon their current practices: 100% of educators reported gaining a better understanding of strategies they use in the classroom and 91% of those educators reported making changes to their implementation after using the Learner Variability Navigator. Having the confidence to use tools and strategies in the classroom that are based on evidence is the first step to supporting better student outcomes. We want to create this same opportunity for AACTE members.
